have learned and can do for themselves.

We are working very hard with all the children in
self-feeding. They can serve themselves by plating
their plate, put away their dirty dishes, forks and
cups.

I would like to ask for your support in helping your
child use a spoon or fork at home. We really would
appreciate this.

We will continue to be working on these skills for
the month of December.

These skills are as follows:

- Self-feeding using a spoon or fork.
- Continue to pour liquid from a small pitcher
onto a cup.
- Put dirty dishes away in designated tub
- Eye and hand coordination (by the child
tracking their hand as they paint,
manipulate an item, or o paint.)
- Pulling clothing up or down while diapering
- Follow one to two oral directions.
- Turn a page or pages from a book
- Respond to their name when being called
upon.
- Repeat new simple vocabulary words.
